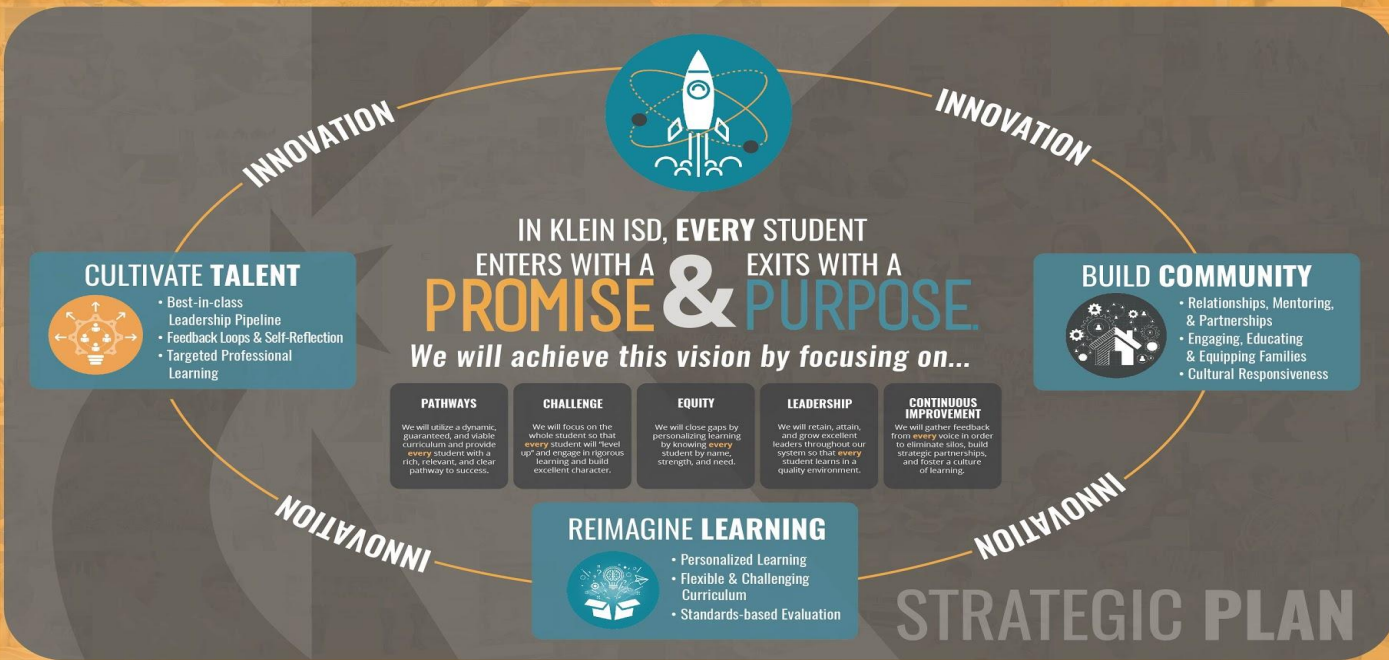

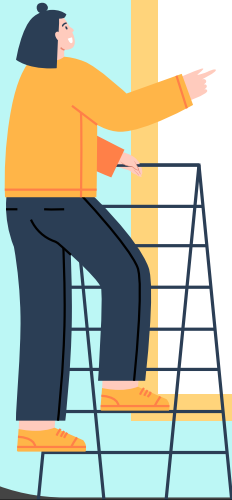

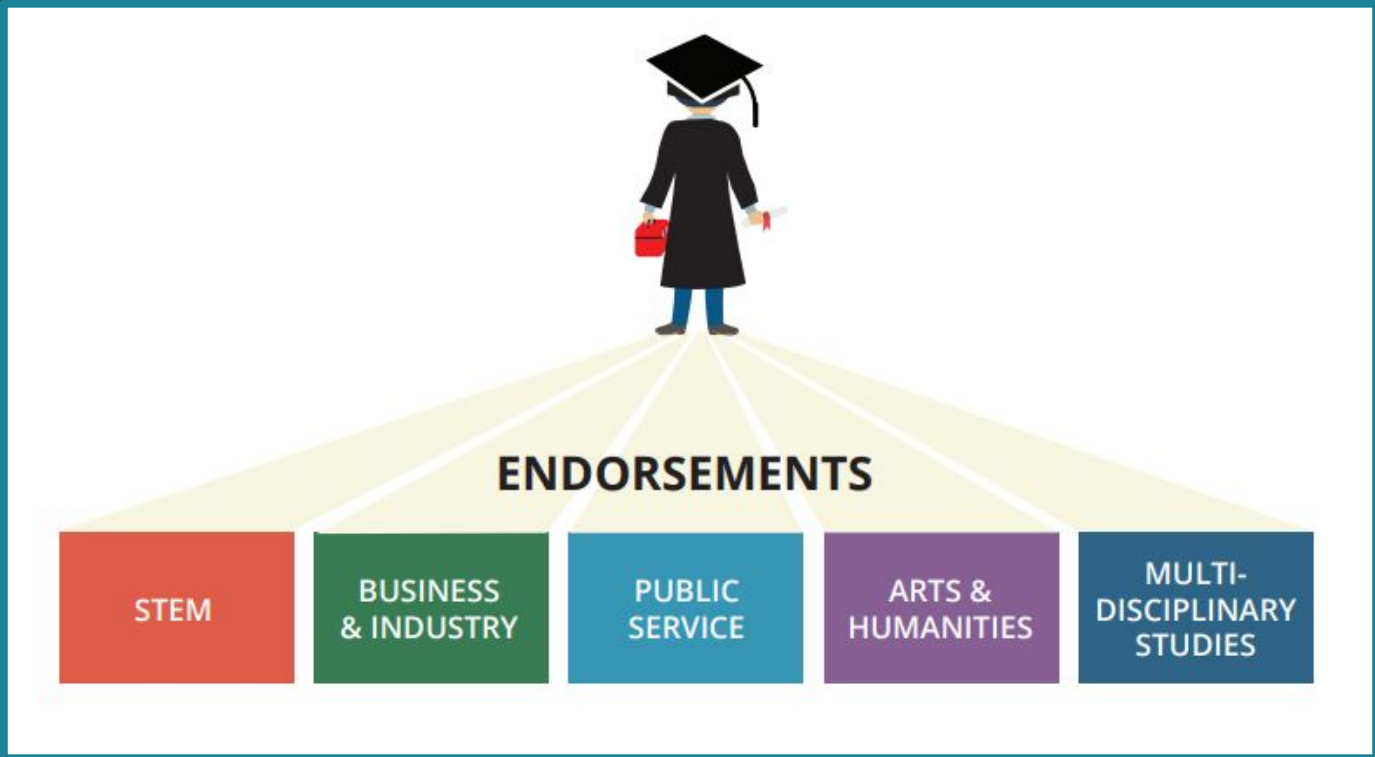
PATHWAYS

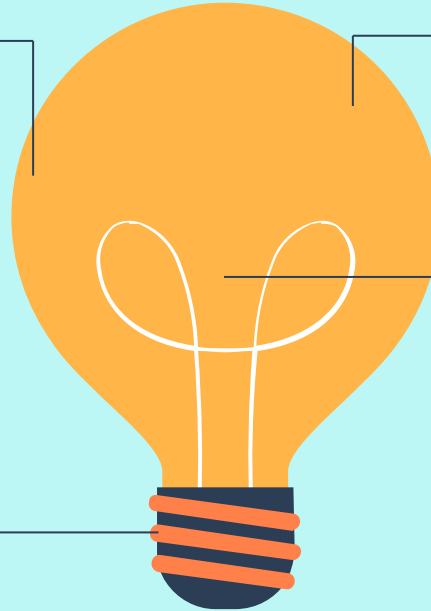

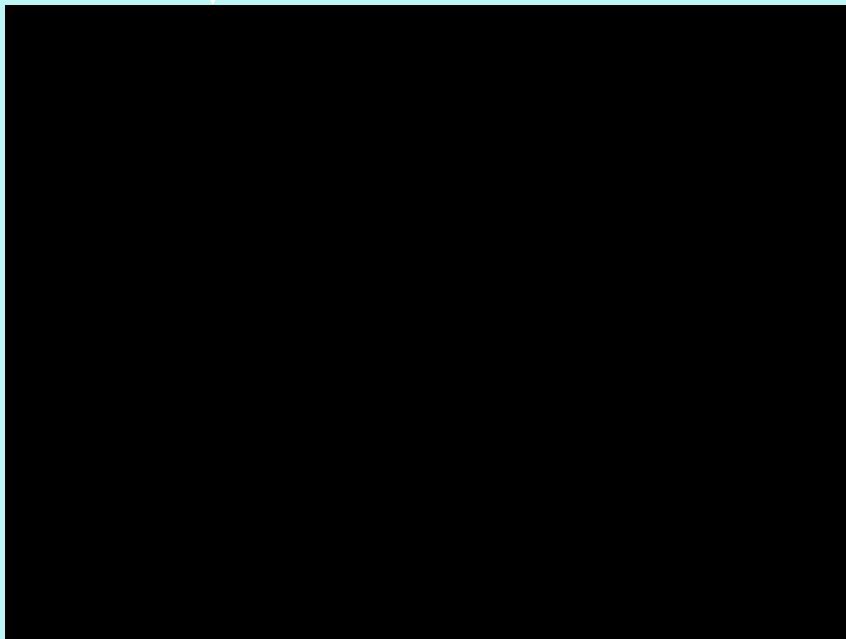

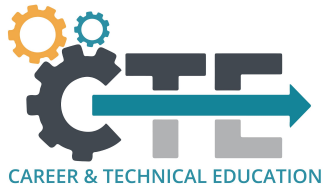
