Meeting Minutes - January 8, 2026

1. Call To Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. by President Noel Tipton.

4. Committee Reports

- **Silent Auction:** Nicole Veliz is the new chair; Please contact her at (832) 580-3528 to arrange pick-up or ask questions about the silent auction. Only one item has been donated as of tonight. Each chapter was encouraged to contribute at least five items. The deadline for submission is January 30, 2026. Alcohol and firearms will not be accepted.
- **Buyer Bags:** Chaired by **Nic Morris** (# 208-705-8379); donations requested (200-250 promotional items (i.e. pens, notepads, coupons, etc.)). Starting to get more items in. Seems to be less items donated than in previous years. There is a business letter for donations that Nic can share for anyone interested. The deadline for items is 02/02/26, but will take items all the way up until the bags are put together. Assembling of bags will take place at the KMPC after the auction set up meeting. Students will assist. Items with a company's logo are fine and any quantity is appreciated.
- **Concessions:** Chaired by **Chad Shaw** (# 281-960-1579); Concessions will remain the same as previous shows with the exception of bbq sandwiches being added. The committee is currently accepting grocery gift cards to help cover some of the costs. Also, taking donations of concession items (candy, chips, drinks). An Amazon Wishlist with the needed items will be available shortly to shop. All donations are needed a week before the show. Rudy's will be the vendor smoking the pork butts.
- **Buyer's Reception:** Chaired by **Joanna Anderson**; The committee is using two vendors for desserts this year. Decorating will occur mid-morning of February 6th and dessert set up the morning of February 7th. Anyone who wants to assist is welcome. Joanna will also need assistance with monitoring the luncheon for additional needs and with cleaning up after the reception.

6. New Business

- **Volunteer Sign-Up:** The SignUp Genius is broken down by show. Each volunteer slot is for two hours, but if you only can do an hour then that is fine.

- Parking Lot Security - directs the traffic. Make sure people don't come in the back end when they shouldn't. Also, help visitors know where to go.
- Concessions - take money and serve food. Very simple job.
- Raffle - sales tickets and shirts.
- Silent Auction - watching over the auction. Answer any questions someone might have about the silent auction.
- Arena - set-up. Help put down shavings for show. After the show is over, help tear down the arena and set-up for the next day's auction.
- Backdrop Monitor - The committee is trying to police the backdrop area better. Class winners have their photos taken. They also take a picture with the judge. Then on auction day, the buyer takes a picture with the kids. Parents and family are asked to remain on the side during this time. Volunteers are needed to guard the area during these critical times. The committee plans on doing a second backdrop in the back of the barn that will be for open use.
- **Buyer Gifts:** Images of the items chosen for auction buyers were displayed. Grand Champion buyer will be a Koozie chair with a can cooler. Reserve Champion buyer will be a can cooler backpack. All other auction buyers will have a choice of a candle, tape measurer, or rechargeable flashlight.

The Show Treasurer needs to be available the whole week of the show. The term is for 3 years. Must have served as treasurer on a booster or have a financial background.
